

CAMPER BEHAVIOR AND SICK POLICIES - Each camper is responsible for his/her own behavior. If your child is having difficulty with another camper, we ask that you help us in reminding your child to seek a camp staff member and allow them to assist in solving the problem. - Any acts of aggression, either provoked or otherwise, will not be tolerated and could result in camp suspension. - Each camper is expected to respect direction from any member of the camp staff, the first time. - Each camper is expected to use appropriate language at all times. - Our camper disciplinary policy is as follows: - Verbal warning with explanation given - Time away from the scheduled activity - Written incident report - Parent conference with possible suspension from the camp program - Removal from camp program without a refund of camp payment - Camper will not be permitted if experiencing any of the following: - Vomiting - Diarrhea - 100+ degree in temperature - Suspicious rash - Any communicable disease (chicken pox, strep throat, ring worm, lice, etc.) > _____INITIALS OF PARENT/GUARDIAN
SWIM/POOL AGREEMENT

I am aware that my child will be required to complete and pass a deep water swim test to allow him/her to swim in the “deep end” (deeper than 3 feet). I understand that a certified lifeguard must deem my child “passed” in order for my child to swim in these noted pool areas. Please advise a camp director or aquatics director in writing if your child has a fear of the water or cannot swim. If a camper does not pass the test but would like to re-take the test at a later date, this can be scheduled with a lifeguard or Camp Director at our convenience. LUNCH PROGRAM Parents must send their campers with a bag lunch or purchase lunch daily. Due to limited refrigeration and kitchen appliances’, please do not send items that require refrigeration or that may need to be heated. Please be sure that your child’s lunch box or bag is labeled with camper’s full name. * Food orders must be placed Monday thru Friday before camp starts for that day.

CHECK IN and PICKUP Children must be accompanied into and out of the program space by a parent or authorized adult(that is listed on the Emergency Contact Form and at least 18 years of age or older) at all times. An authorized adult must sign the in/out roster and may be required to present a photo ID to ensure that this safety regulation is enforced. > _____INITIALS OF PARENT/GUARDIAN

EARLY ARRIVAL is available for all Activities and Swim & Swing camps, attendees can arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of camp. Campers are not allowed to be dropped off prior to this time. Camp Attendees can be picked up no later than 4:30pm and signed out by an adult that has been predetermined at check in that morning. All campers must be signed in daily by a parent or legal guardian before being left for camp. A photo ID may be required when dropping a child off for camp. Campers with medicine will be directed to the medical personnel on hand or authorized staff to fill out the required Medication Administration Authorization Form prior to camper being allowed to enter camp. > _____INITIALS OF PARENT/GUARDIAN

LATE PICK UP of Summer Camp Programs past 30 minutes at close of Camp will be subject at an hourly fee of \$25 per hour. Parents are considered late if the child had not been picked up by that time (regardless of the reason). Repeated lateness could cause dismissal from the program. Payment for late fees is due within 24 hours of the date of late pick up – late payment fees and suspensions for non-payment may apply. > _____INITIALS OF PARENT/GUARDIAN

FORMS AND ACCOUNT INFORMATION It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to notify staff of any medical information pertinent to their child's health, safety and well being; and to provide updated medical records as necessary. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to keep telephone and emergency information updated in their child's account with the camp directors or assistant directors.
